APRIL 2018 POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

During the month of April 2018 the police department responded to and handled 94 calls for service; of those incidents 29 required written reports.

There were 24 State Traffic, 7 City and 5 Written Warnings issued.

There were 8 traffic/non-traffic arrests made.

On May 2, 2018 after all background checks, physical agility and medical exam was completed for our new hire, Shawn Keith, I contacted the Police Training Institute in Champaign to check on the availability for training. Their enrollment for their next class had ended the day before, on May 1st. In talking with officials at the school I learned they had a cancellation which vacated one remaining slot for the training scheduled from May 21 – August 23, 2018. They allowed us to enroll Shawn in that class. Until he reports at PTI on Sunday May 20th Shawn will be working split duties in the office and riding along with certified officers.

The 2018 Ford Taurus has been ordered with delivery being possibly 6 – 12 weeks out. We were able to pay for the car out of the 2017 appropriations. The 2013 Chevrolet, which will be traded to Yemm Ford, has had the emergency equipment removed and awaits delivery of the new car before it will be gone.

We are still awaiting the response from the Illinois Law Enforcement Officers Training and Standards Board regarding our waiver request for Officer Barry Petzold. If this waiver is not granted we will be required to send him to PTI as well. He comes to us with an extensive law enforcement background from out of state so I am optimistic we will be granted this waiver.
