MINUTES

Call to Order: Mayor Maurer called the City of Knoxville Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. All rose to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present: Aldermen Eiker, Gruner, Hillier, Howard, Myers, Naslund; Mayor Maurer, Treasurer Bivens, City Clerk Wilt. **Absent:** Alderman Benjamin. Also in attendance: one member of the press.

Public Comments: None.

As there were no members of the public present, Mayor Maurer closed the Public Hearing at 7:05 PM.

Call to Order: Mayor Maurer called the Special City Council Meeting to order at 7:05 PM.

Roll Call: Present: Aldermen Eiker, Gruner, Hillier, Howard, Myers, Naslund; Mayor Maurer, Treasurer Bivens, City Clerk Wilt. **Absent:** Alderman Benjamin. Also in attendance: one member of the press.

Adoption of the 2019-2020 Appropriations Ordinance for the City of Knoxville: Mayor Maurer proposed adding a line item for Street Department Computer Maintenance and Support, 716-004, for \$1,000.00 for the department internet. Alderman **Gruner moved** to approve Ordinance 2019-08 Annual Appropriation Ordinance, including that addition. Alderman **Eiker seconded** the motion, which **passed** with six (6) Yes votes and one (1) Absent.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:

Alderman Myers recommended researching options when the water contract with the City of Galesburg expires.

Alderman Gruner recommended taking the waste water treatment plant operations in house at the conclusion of the BOCK Inc contract agreement in 2024.

Mayor Maurer reported that there is no visible peak on the City Hall roof in old photographs. Changing the roof may negate the building's National Historic Register status.
