# SEPTEMBER 2021 POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

During the month of September 2021 the police department responded to and handled 128 calls for service; of those incidents 55 required written reports.

There were 49 calls for service handled by the Knox County Sheriff's Department during the time we had no Knoxville officers available for work. To date there have been 117 calls the sheriff's department has handled for us since our staffing issues has been in such a depleted state.

The in-car radar and camera systems have been installed into 3 squads and are currently in use. The body camera systems has still not been implemented due to the triggering mechanism that was approved at the October 4<sup>th</sup> council meeting. These cameras will also be put into use once that addition/upgrade is complete.

There were 3 State Traffic, 18 City and 60 Written Warnings issued.

There were 7 traffic/non-traffic arrests made.
