OCTOBER 2023 POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

During the month of October 2023 the police department responded to and handled 220 calls for service; of those incidents 54 required written reports.

There were 22 State Traffic, 5 City and 86 Written Warnings issued.

There were 11 traffic/non-traffic arrests made.

Officer Logan Butler is also a member of the Army Reserves, he has been deployed to Guantanamo Bay the last of September. He will be on this deployment for approximately 1-year. During this time we continue to be under-staffed.

I've been in contact with Morrow Brothers Ford where our new squad car was approved for back in January of this year. At the time of this report there is no vehicle yet and it is unknown if Ford will cancel the build. It appears to be unlikely we will ever see this unit.
