RESOLUTION 2024-

A RESOLUTION AMENDING ESTABLISHING NEW PERMIT FEE AMOUNTS FOR THE OPENING OF, OR EXCAVATION, OF PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS, TERRACES OR RIGHT-OF-WAYS

WHEREAS, the City of Knoxville, Knox County, Illinois ("City") has authority to control its real property including streets, rights of ways and terraces owned by the City;

WHEREAS, Section 24-2-2 of the Knoxville Municipal Code requires that, before a permit shall be issued by the City to any person to open or make an excavation in any street, sidewalk, public alley or right-of-way for a street or alley, the permit fee(s) shall be paid to the City of Knoxville, which fees shall be established by City Council resolution from time to time

WHEREAS, the permit fees charged by the City of Knoxville pursuant to Section 24-2-2 of the Knoxville Municipal Code, have not kept pace with the costs of administering the permit system for the protection of City right of ways; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Knoxville has found that it is in the best interests of the City, to amend Appendix A of the Knoxville City Code ("Code"), regarding the permit fees required by Section 24-2-2 of the Knoxville Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Knoxville, Knox County, Illinois as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Section 24-2-2-A of Appendix A of the Knoxville Municipal Code is hereby amended, to provide as follows:

SEC. 24-2-2-A: Permit Fees and charges

\$50 per property (i.e., per platted property with a separate property identification number) for excavations between the curb (or the paved or graveled area, if there is no curb) and the sidewalk (or the edge of the City's right-of-way, if there is no sidewalk); in other words, \$50 per property in what is colloquially known as the terrace).

Basic permit fee for excavation within street or alley right-of-way except within the curb lines or street surface of a Street:

\$400 plus \$50 times the number of properties adjacent to the excavation for any excavation which is one-half or less of street width.

\$700 plus \$50 times the number of properties adjacent to the excavation for any excavation which is greater than one-half the street width.

\$100 for boring under the street or within curb lines without any excavation.

\$250 For replacement (or relocation) of culvert as per Sec. 24-4-5.

Section 2: Effective Date: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
