During the month of September 2025 the police department responded to and handled 166 calls for service; of those incidents 53 required written reports.

There were 11 State Traffic, 1 City and 10 Written Warnings issued.

There were 9 traffic/non-traffic arrests made.

We've had three incidents in September where people have had car windows broken out with rocks. We believe this is being committed by juveniles and have strong ideas on they are.
