

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE  
OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Knoxville, Illinois, hereby finds that the following item of personal property owned by the City is no longer necessary or useful to the City: 1982 Ford LN700 (street sweeper) (hereinafter, the "personal property"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the sale of said personal property would be in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1.**     Sale of Personal Property

The Department head of the Department holding or primarily using the personal property shall arrange for the sale of the property using his or her discretion and best efforts, consistent with the following terms indicated below by an "x":

- XXXXX     The personal property shall be sold without advertisement unless the Department head determines that advertisement would likely garner a better purchase price.
- \_\_\_\_\_     The personal property shall be sold by advertisement. The advertisement will require sealed bids to be received by \_\_\_\_\_.
- \_\_\_\_\_     The personal property will be sold by advertisement without the necessity of sealed bids.
- \_\_\_\_\_     A minimum purchase price of \$\_\_\_\_\_ will be required.
- \_\_\_\_\_     No minimum purchase price is required.

**Section 2.**     Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
