JULY 2026 POLICE DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT

During the month of July 2026 the police department responded to and handled 195 calls for service; of those incidents 24 required written reports.

There were 5 State Traffic, 8 City and 6 Written Warnings issued.

There were 10 traffic/non-traffic arrests made.

With respect to the numerous solicitor complaints, we located and issued citations to 7 violators.

Another area that has been problematic all summer was several complaints of someone banging on doors and windows of residents all throughout town and running away. Eventually one resident had security camera that captured video of one of these violations, the video was good enough, officers were able to identify one of the juveniles in it. At this point 7 involved juveniles have been identified and have had initial interviews. The case is still in process wherein citations will be issued soon.

Update on our officers currently in their training at the Macon County Law Enforcement Training Center are due to graduate on August 21. Our 3rd new officer will be going to SWIC, in Belleville starting on August 16th. I could not get him enrolled in a training academy closer to home so our fuel cost will be affected by this.
